

The pop art of Cuomo conquers Sorrento: to him the Fata Verde award.

"One" is his first work of art, from there it all began. From that replication of faces that meet in a kiss, the idea was born to use the motif of the painting to adorn the sinuous lines of a Range Rover Evoque. Francesco Cuomo, Ebolian painter, won the Fata Verde Award in the Art Car section of the Sorrento Young Art, curated by Rossella Savarese.

«My passion has been rewarded and for this I am even more proud of this result - he says -. From that painting my whole vision of contemporary art and collectible design was born ».

During the evening, the "Art in Motion" project was also presented by Cuomo together with the director Enrico Agresta. A multimedia work in which the works of contemporary artists come to life through 3D mapping projections: "We have worked on it for two years and I am happy to have presented it in this frame," says Cuomo.

It is a technique of animation of works of art thanks to a digital work and the editing of a video in which the decomposed works take on new forms. The paintings of the selected artists come to life, the characters of the work move creating a unique spectacle, catapulting the visitor into the work.

Several works by Cuomo exhibited in a group show at Syart until May 13th. The exhibition presents more than thirty national and international artists, divided into stylistic sections, in the exhibition rooms of the historic Villa Fiorentino residence.
